Channel Christian School is a growing coeducational school providing the highest quality Christ-centred education for students from Kindergarten through to Year 6. The four teachers with provisional registration are provided appropriate professional development opportunities to progress to full registration.

During 2021, all teaching staff were involved in professional development, including:


