## From the Principal

Last week I had the pleasure of attending the EduTECH conference in Sydney. I had an opportunity to listen to great speakers such as Sir Ken Robinson, the world's elite thinker on creativity and innovation; as well as Dr Richard Harris, Australian of the Year 2019 & an Australian hero involved in the Thai Cave dive rescue.

There was also an exhibition on the latest technology, learning spaces ideas and learning games and apps. Throughout the conference there was a strong focus on enabling teachers and students to be creative in their teaching and learning, in the way we assess, as well as in the delivery of subject content.

Our God is a creative God, the creator of heaven and earth! We are made in His image and therefore share His characteristics. Because God is creative, we can be creative in our work and are in fact called to such creativity. The danger is that in our current system of schooling we squash the creativity of our students and teachers because of the demands placed on us by a very full government prescribed curriculum, evidence based learning/assessments, time restrictions with timetabling and even our current physical environment. Teachers are constantly grappling with this tension.

### **Our third thread is Reflecting Creativity:**

Looking at everything around us should convince us that creativity is one of the fundamental parts of God's character and one of the joys of His existence. When He says "Be like me and do what I do", He intended for us to be creative, in all that we do.

## **Essential questions:**

- Does everyone have a gift of creativity?
- How did God make me creative?
- How does creativity extend beyond simply works of art?
- In what ways is reflecting creativity both service to God and service to others?


